

Recommendation October 22, 2019:

We as the show committee recommend that all cattle born prior to January of 2020 just be DNA profile to be eligible for any BAA shows or sales. All calves born after January of 2020 will be required to be DNA profiled and parent verified. All calves showing as a cow calf pair will not have to be profiled or DNA verified unless they are also showing individually.

We recommend all hair samples be sent into the BAA office, so that they may be gathered together and sent to the lab. This will decrease confusion by sending samples in only 1 time a week.

We are recommending not to alter any rules and regulations for ET or AI calves at this time.

We also recommend hair samples be collected on all cows that pass away or are sold prior to their shipment. This will prevent any questions of parent verification in the future. We only recommend this if you would consider ever participating in a BAA sale or show with one of the cow/bulls offspring's.
